Who May Attend Faculty Meetings

Voting Members: The following people have voting privileges and so count toward the quorum of faculty meetings.

- All regular (that is, full-time, non-visiting) Faculty in residence with the title of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, and Instructor
- Faculty members on leave or teaching abroad (assuming prior notice to the Clerk of attendance at the meeting)
- Regular librarians with professional status (full-time and non-visiting)
- President
- Provost
- Dean of the Faculty
- Vice President for Human Resources and General Counsel
- Vice President for Campus Life
- Chaplain

Regularly Invited Members: The following people may attend faculty meetings, but may not vote.

- Part time and visiting members of the Faculty and members of the teaching faculty with titles other than those listed above
- Faculty emeriti
- Dean of Students
- The Associate and Assistant Deans
- Registrar
- All Vice Presidents of the College not previously mentioned:
 - VP and Chief Information Officer
 - VP and Chief Investment Officer
 - VP and Liaison to the Board of Trustees
 - VP for Development & College Relations
 - VP for Enrollment Management
 - VP for Finance and Administration and Treasurer
 - VP for Marketing & Communications
- Student representatives serving on Faculty Committees

Other invited members: The President may nominate other members of the administrative staff to be invited by the Faculty when meeting business impinges on their expertise.
